

All players, coaches and managers are urged to read the <u>CDSFA Judiciary Disciplinary & Appeals Regulations</u>, to understand:

- · Actions that can lead to the CDSFA issuing the club with a fine
- The Red Card process
- The CDSFA disciplinary and appeals process

Where CDSFA issues the Club with a fine, the responsible player, coach, manager or team will be required to pay the fine (and in some cases an administration fee) to the Club.

- Specific player fines are to be paid by the player and failure to do so may result in suspension from playing and, ultimately, de-registration.
- Fines for team offences are the responsibility of the manager to collect. Payments may be deducted from match official reimbursement requests or paid directly to the club where this option is not available.

If you believe that there are mitigating circumstances, you must advise the Club in writing.
