



How to Register – Working With Children Check

The safety and wellbeing of our players is a top priority at Ashfield Pirates FC. Anyone volunteering as a coach, manager or in an official role must hold a valid Working With Children Check. The process is free for volunteers and helps ensure we continue to provide a safe, welcoming and trusted environment for all families. Registering is simple, and once completed, your clearance can be used across multiple organisations. Click the link below to apply or update your details.

Working With Children Check – Quick Checklist

All coaches, managers and volunteers must:

- Hold a **valid NSW Working With Children Check (WWCC)**
 - Ensure the check is **registered as a volunteer**
 - Provide their **WWCC number to Ashfield Pirates FC**
 - Keep their WWCC **current and up to date**

Frequently Asked Questions

Who needs a Working With Children Check?

All coaches, managers and volunteers who work with or are regularly around junior players must hold a valid WWCC.

Is the Working With Children Check free?

Yes. The WWCC is **free for volunteers**.

Do parents need a WWCC?

Parents helping in an official role (coach, manager, regular helper) do. Parents spectating or helping occasionally do not.

How long does the WWCC last?

A WWCC is valid for **five years**, provided it remains current and compliant.

Can I use my WWCC from another organisation?

Yes. A WWCC can be used across multiple clubs and organisations, you just need to provide your number at time of registration.

When do I need to have it completed?

Your WWCC must be approved **before** you can begin your role.

Where can I register for my WWCC?

You can register by visiting Services NSW website or going directly to a Services NSW office.
