

Wet Weather Procedures

When there is a risk of injury to players or damage to playing surfaces, fields may be closed by local councils, clubs or referees. Closures can occur **at any time**, including after teams arrive at the ground or even **during a match**.

If a Pirates home field is closed and another field is available, **matches may be** relocated at very short notice. For this reason, it is essential to check the draw regularly.

How We Communicate Closures

- The club will post updates regarding training and Pirates home ground closures on Facebook as soon as information is available
- For **competition matches**, the official status of your game must be checked on **DRIBL**:

Understanding Game Status in DRIBL

- **PENDING** The match is proceeding as scheduled (date, time and venue remain unchanged)
- WASHOUT RESCHEDULE The field is closed and the match will be replayed on a later date
- WASHOUT CANCELLED The field is closed and the match is cancelled entirely

Council Information

Local council hotlines and websites (such as <u>Inner West Council ground status</u> <u>updates</u>) can provide helpful information, however **DRIBL** is always the final authority for competition matches.
