ASHFIELD PIRATES COMPETITION INFORMATION

- 1. Eligibility: Children (boys or girls) from the age of 4 18 years, Women's, Over 35, over 45, Over 50's, BBC and All Age men's. 2 Number of players per team:
- 2a. U4's U7's 7 players (field 4 & 3 substitutes)
- 2b. U8's U9's 11 players (field 7 & 4 substitutes)
- 2c. U10's U12's boys or girls 13 players (field 9 & 4 substitutes)
- 2d. U13s boys or girls and above 16 players (field 11 & 5 substitutes)
- 3d. Women, BBC, Over 35, Over 45, Over 50's & All Age men's 22 players (Field 11 & 5 substitutes)
- 3 Players' age shall be determined from the age he or she turns between January 1st and December 31st (both dates inclusive) of the current year.
- 4 Competition Days:
- Non-competitive: (U4 U11's) Saturday from 0800 1200. A complete time and draw will be provided for all age groups.
- Competitive: (Women, Girls only & U12's & above) Sunday from 0900 1700. A complete time and draw will be provided for all age groups.
- Competitive: (All Age Men, BBC, Over 35, Over 45's & Over 50's) Saturday from 1230 1830. A complete time and draw will be provided for all age groups.
- 5 Training Days: Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday between 1700 2100 for **One hour only** at Hammond Park, Ashfield. Tuesday & Thursday between 1700 2100 for One hour only at Pratten Park, Ashfield.
- 6 Correct uniform, soccer boots/ footwear and shin pads must be worn at all training sessions and games.
- 7. Player parents or guardians must sign the registration form, therefore agree to adhere to the APFC Code of Conduct (see attached).
- 8 Participants agree to indemnify APFC and its Officers against all claims, demands, actions and liabilities of any kind (other than due to willful negligence) including injuries, breakages, loss or theft, in the course of participating in the Soccer training or Competitions.
- 9 Children registering with APFC with a medical issue must provide a letter from his/her doctor regarding treatment of the condition.
- 10 Children remain the responsibility of the parents or guardians. APFC will take no responsibility for injury to children sustained through a lack of supervision from parents or guardians.
- 11. Once the deposit or full registration fees have been paid there will be "No Refund". Initial:
- 12 De-registration must be done in writing and sent through to club secretary & or DRIBL App.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Play by the rules.
- 2. Never argue with a referee, assistant referee or officials. If you disagree, have your coach or manager approach the official on your behalf.
- 3. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviour in soccer and especially at the Pirates Football Club.
- 4. Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- 5. Be a good sport; recognise all good plays whether they are part of your team or the opposition.
- 6. Treat all participants in soccer as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of other competitors.
- 7. Cooperate with your coach, team-mates and opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- 8. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit; not just to please parents and coaches.
- 9. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

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- 10. All players 16years & above must be double vaccinated & show vaccination certificate when requested by an official. Only those players will be allowed to compete in any training or games.

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Remember that children participate in sport for their enjoyment.
- 2. Encourage children to participate, do not force them.
- 3. Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- 4. Encourage children always to play according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 5. Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- 6. Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performances and skillful plays by all participants.
- 7. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from all of soccer's activities.
- 8. Respect official's decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- 9. Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- 9A. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion. **Initial:**
- 10. All parents & or Guardians must be double vaccinated & show vaccination certificate when requested by an official. Only those parents & or Guardians will be allowed to attend any training or games.

SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Remember that young people participate for their enjoyment and benefit, not yours.
- 2. Applaud good performance and efforts from all individuals and teams. Congratulate all participants on their performance regardless of the game's outcome.
- 3. Respect the decisions of officials and teach junior players to do the same. The Referee is always right.
- 4. Never ridicule or scold a player for making a mistake. Positive comments are motivational.
- 5. Condemn the use of violence in any form, whether it is by spectators, coaches, officials or players.
- 6. Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- 7. Encourage players to follow the rules and the officials' decisions.
- 8. Do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches or officials.
- 9. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion. **Initial:**
